INTEGRATED MILL: BASIC OXYGEN FURNACE






BASIC OXYGEN FURNACE

- **Primary Inputs:** Iron ore, coal, limestone, scrap
- **Power Source:** Coal, Electricity, Natural Gas

- Up to 20-30% recycled content
- Accounts for 70% of global steel production
- Average carbon intensity: 2.33 tons GHG/ton



MINI MILL: ELECTRIC ARC FURNACE






ELECTRIC ARC FURNACE

- Primary Input: Scrap steel DRI/supplemental inputs Up to 90+% recycled content
- Power Source: Electricity

- Accounts for 30% of global steel production
- Average carbon intensity: 0.66 tons GHG/ton

Nucor values transparency and will continue to **publicly disclose and reduce** our Scope 1, Scope 2, and Scope 3 GHG emissions.




Beyond 2030, Nucor is committed to reducing our GHG emissions with the **ambition of net zero emission steel** to meet the demands of the green economy.


